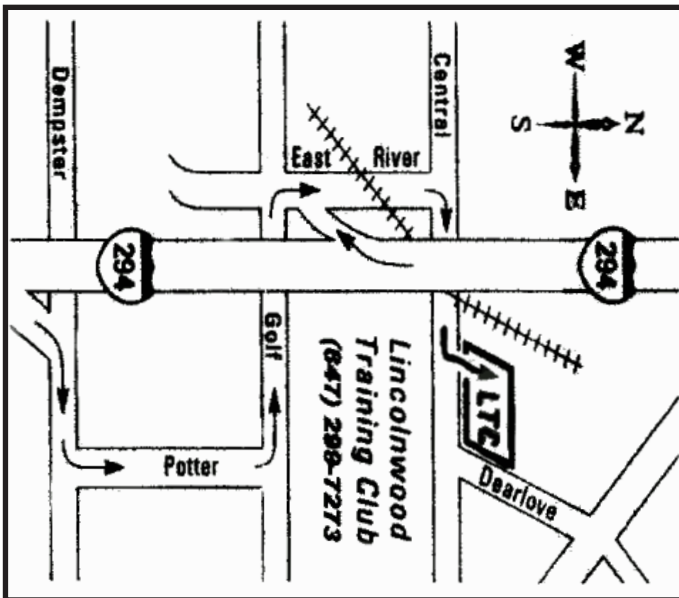

SPECIAL NOTICE ON PRECAUTIONS ADVISED RELATING TO COVID-19 VIRUS

Thank you in advance for complying with these rules so that we have a safe and successful trial. And thank you for your consideration for all attending our trial. These precautions include most of the AKC’s recommendations as they apply to outdoor shows.

--- For the health and safety of our judge, trial committee, volunteers, and exhibitors, only competitors will be allowed on the property this year.

--- Please DO NOT COME to our trial if you feel sick, or if you have tested positive, or if you have been exposed to Covid-19 in the last 14 days before the trial. DO NOT COME if you are concerned about being exposed to the Coronavirus. Please do not enter if you are not willing to follow the rules.

--- Please bring a face mask to the trial. We ARE NOT requiring exhibitors to wear a mask while showing in the ring due to the heat. However, we are requiring everyone wear a mask everywhere else on club grounds. You will not be able to enter the clubhouse without wearing a mask.

--- Please maintain a 6-foot social distance while interacting with anyone at the trial.

--- Disinfecting spray will be available in the restrooms. Please spray down anything you touch while in there.

--- Hand sanitizer will be available in areas throughout the grounds for your use. However, please wash your hands using soap and water as frequently as possible.

--- There will not be crating in the building for dogs. Should you choose to crate on the field, please remember to social distance.

Highest Combined Score in the Preferred Open and Preferred Utility Classes.....Blue and Green Rosette and \$30 cash

Highest Combined Score in the Rally Advanced B and Excellent B Classes.....Blue and Green Rosette and \$30 cash

Highest Combined Triple Qualifying Score in the Rally Advanced B, Excellent B, and Master Classes.....Blue and Red Rosette and \$30 cash

All qualifying scores will receive a Dark Green qualifying ribbon. New Title rosettes will be awarded to dogs earning a title at this trial.

Please note: All prizes must be picked up at Lincolnwood's Trials. None will be mailed.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS:

Entry fee is \$25 for the first entry of each dog in each event, and \$15 for each additional entry of the same dog in the same event. Entry fee for each Brace team is \$25 per team. The Obedience and Rally Trials are separate events and require separate first entry fees. Entries will not be accepted without the proper fees and signatures and must be on approved entry forms with the agreement on the reverse side. Please TYPE or PRINT plainly all information on the entry forms except for signatures.

A recording fee of 50 cents and a \$3.00 AKC event service fee on the first entry of a dog, and a \$3.00 AKC event service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular single-entry classes, will be collected at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial, and/or rally trial. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the AKC. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

NO ENTRY FEES will be refunded except those of bitches who come in season after the closing date. In those cases, the entry fee will be returned, less \$5, upon receipt of the original signed statement from a veterinarian to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 a.m. the day of the Trial. **NO ENTRY FEES** will be returned if show cannot open or be completed by reasons of civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergencies, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other causes beyond the control of Lincolnwood Training Club.

Lincolnwood Training Club, Inc. for German Shepherd Dogs, its officers, and the trial committee assume NO responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, visitors, or any dogs or property and assumes no responsibility for their children. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to insure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Judging of dogs in catalog order will begin promptly at the hour appointed. Dogs are numbered consecutively in each class, with a starting and ending number shown. The dogs are numbered so that the handler may estimate the approximate time he or she will be called by allowing ten (10) dogs per hour in Beginner Novice; nine (9) dogs per hour in Novice and Preferred Novice; eight (8) dogs per hour in Graduate Novice, Preferred Open, and Open; seven (7) dogs per hour in Graduate Open, Utility, and Preferred Utility. The handler should be at ringside well before the calculated time in case absentees or other conditions should advance the schedule. Judges are not required to wait for dogs, and it is the responsibility of each contestant to be ready with his or her dog at ringside, when required, without waiting to be called. Judges may judge dogs entered in more than one class in other than catalog order but cannot be asked to wait. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused after they have been judged.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (VETERANS & BRACE)

The Veterans class shall be for dogs that have any obedience title and are seven or more years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice class. Dogs entered in the Veterans class may be entered in another class or classes.

The Brace class will be for two dogs of the same breed. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled (the coupling device will be not less than 6 inches in overall length). Whichever method is used will be continued throughout all exercises. Exercises, performances, and judging will be as in the Novice class.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES, EXCEPT WHEN REQUIRED IN THE RING. NO UNENTERED DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD.
